However, there were also some really fun parts to this testing. Really. I probably liked it because it turns out I was really good at these.

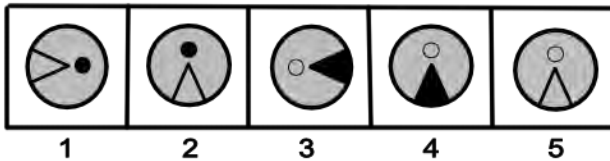
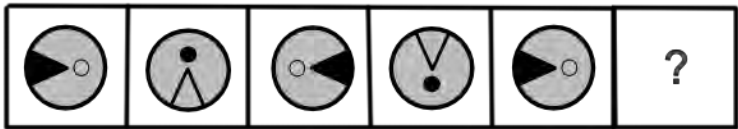
